

OFFLINE COURSE INFORMATION FOR THE INTENSIVE/PRIVATE PROGRAM

Overview

The intensive/private program is created by arrangement between INCULS and course participants, i.e. length of study and budgeting.

This program consists of a language/culture course and additional activities (optional) based on the participant’s request, namely:

1. **Language class** :
 Consists of reading, grammar, vocabulary, writing, and conversation class.
2. **Additional activity** :
 - a. Tutorial (a supplementary activity to learn bahasa Indonesia after class, the tutor is a student of Universitas Gadjah Mada).
 - b. Special lectures on Indonesia (Indonesian Economics, Indonesian Politics, Indonesian Literature, Indonesian History and Archaeology, Indonesian Cultures and Society, etc.), delivered in English.
 - c. Field study (a visit to company/institution/school/organization)
 - d. Batik/Gamelan/Traditional dance (Javanese or Balinese)/Pencak Silat (Indonesian traditional Martial Art)/Indonesian Cooking/Silver jewelry workshop.
 - e. Field trip (heritage sites in Yogyakarta and around, Lava Tour of Merapi, etc.).
 - f. Village Studies.

These additional activities can only be run if there are a minimum of 5 participants, except for tutorials. If there are less participants, an additional fee might be charged.

Following is an example for the program arrangement :

Facilities provided :

- Course and academic book
- Air-conditioned classrooms
- Free internet access
- Reading room/library

- Free drinks (mineral water, tea, and coffee)
- Airport pick-up and drop-off (less than 20 participants)

At the end of the course, students will receive a certificate of completion and a transcript signed by the Dean of the Faculty of Cultural Sciences, Gadjah Mada University.

Note :

- INCULS provides the list of accommodation (hotel, boarding house, guest house, and homestay), but we do not make any arrangements for students' accommodation unless a special request is made by the institution.
